- Calangute Beach One of the most popular Beaches of Goa lies on Calangute town. It is also the largest beach of North Goa. Checked out by hundreds of vacationers from everywhere particularly in the months of November – December; it's filled with sports tasks, night life as well as tourist destinations.
- Baga Beach Baga beach Goa located at a westward distance of about 8 km from Mapusa. Goa Baga beach is really an extension of Calangute beach North of Panaji. This beach along the Arabian Sea exists in between Calangute and Anjuna beaches. Baga beach about 15 km from Panaji is named after Baga River which flows through this area.
- Anjuna Beach Anjuna Beach is not just another popular Beach of Goa however location which has
  actually seen Hippie culture long back and also whose flea market still stands the primary setting! The
  most renowned Beach among foreigners; this sea side is well-known among back-packers, hippies, longstayers and also the ones that are seeking cheap keeps or guesthouses.

As the second day of your Goa tour itinerary comes to an end, return to the resort and sleep off the night.

- **Shri Manguesh Temple at Priol** Shri Mangesh Templel ies at Mangeshi Village in Priol, Ponda taluk, Goa. It goes to a distance of 1 km from Mardol close to Nagueshi, 21 km from Panaji the resources of Goa, and also 26 kilometres from Margao. This Temple is one of the biggest as well as most regularly visited temples in Goa.

Next off, travel to the churches of Old Goa like Basilica of Bom Jesus and Se Basilica. Post lunch; visit the Dona Paula Bay as well as Miramar Beach. In the future, your Goa vacation, enjoy street shopping at the Panjim Market.

In the evening, enjoy boat cruise at the Mandovi River. Towards the end of the day, return to the hotel and sleep off the night.
